 Cause of death *Phthisis*"

And an Undertaker's Certificate, signed by *Edwin Carlin*, undertaker, having been also presented to and filed with me, setting forth that said body has been prepared by said undertaker for transportation in every particular as required for such cases by Law and the Rules of the Board of Health of the State of New Jersey:

PERMISSION is hereby granted to convey said body by *boat* from *Camden* in the County of *Camden* New Jersey, to *Phila* in the County of *Phila* in the State of *Penn* and *E. Carlin* is hereby authorized to accompany said body in such transit.

Dated at *Camden* County of *Camden* New Jersey, this *24* day of *March* A.D. 19 *01*

22-This Permit should be delivered to the person authorized to accompany the dead body, provided that when the body is shipped by express this permit should be tacked upon the outside of the coffin box. No coffin box should be received for transportation from which any fluids or offensive odors are escaping. The coupons are not required by the laws of New Jersey, and are added to this blank to meet the requirements of the sanitary authorities in New York City.
